- (c) the details of seats reserved for SC/ST in homoeopathy colleges in the country?

(a): There are 204 Homoeopathy Colleges functioning in the country with 14158 Under Graduate (UG) seats and 1149 Post Graduate (PG) seats. The State/ UT-wise list of colleges is given in **Annexure**.

(b): Health is a State subject. The Central Government does not maintain the data regarding the number of homoeopathy doctors employed at present.

(c): The reserved seats for SC / ST are allotted as per the prevailing Policies of the States / UTs concerned. Ministry of AYUSH does not maintain the data regarding the number of seats reserved for SC/ST in homoeopathy colleges in the country.
