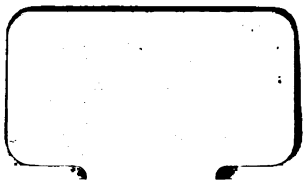

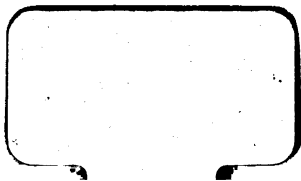

INTRODUCTION.

HOMŒOPATHY is the science of curing disease in the Human body by the application of a medicament known to produce in a healthy body like symptoms to those for which it is offered as a cure ; one medicine alone being administered at a time, and in a small dose ; experience having demonstrated that a small dose possesses more real curative powers than a larger dose of the same ; consequently no ill effects can arise in the system by the quantity of medicine taken ; and all such violent and painful applications as blisters, bleeding, cupping, leeches, plasters, &c., are entirely avoided.

The great benefits to be derived from Homœopathic medicines cannot be imagined by those who have never experienced them : the blessing which they confer on parents, especially in the various complaints of children, will be estimated by those only who have had to administer draughts, powders, &c., and to apply the tortures prescribed under the old system ; instead of being compelled to *force* children with Homœopathic medicines, it is always found that they are anxious to take them, and the quick and surprising effects produced are certain, and often astonishing even to those constantly in the habit of using them.

The accompanying Guide has been compiled chiefly for the use of those who are unable to purchase expensive works on Homœopathy, or a large variety of Medicines ; it refers to twenty-five of

the most useful remedies for domestic treatment, selected from the list of about three hundred, used by Homœopathic Physicians, and such have been chosen, as may, if carefully selected, be safely used in the most severe cases previous to the arrival of the physician who should of course be sent for in such an emergency.

The appropriate remedies placed against each symptom or part of the body affected, have been selected on a careful comparison of Jahr's Manual, Bonninghausen's Therapeutics, Chepmell's, Curie's, Epp's, Laurie's, and Pulte's Domestic Homœopathies. Other medicines might doubtless have been chosen in the place of some, but it being requisite to select for the purpose as few as possible, those most usually recommended have been adopted.

It is the earnest wish of the compiler to assist in making Homœopathy not only known, but practically useful in every family, however poor. For those whose circumstances enable them to procure some of the excellent domestic Manuals already published, this work has not been prepared, although it is believed they will derive some assistance in their search for appropriate remedies, by the simple alphabetical form in which it is arranged.

In conclusion, the compiler would just say that some few copies of his little work in manuscript have been used with much success in several families of his acquaintance, and he now commits it to the press with the hope that it may by that means be more extensively useful.

DIRECTIONS.

To find the appropriate remedy in any case, the whole of the symptoms of the complaint should be carefully written down, with the part of the body affected, then against each symptom add the remedies inserted in this Guide ; afterwards compare them, and the medicine named either against all the symptoms, or the greater portion, should be the one selected ; or if several should be found named under each symptom, either of them may be used, as in the following case :—

TEETHING, Acon. Bell. *Cham.* Coff.

In this case *Belladonna* appears to be the most appropriate.

The quantity to be administered in one dose should be, in general, one Globule for Children, two for Females or persons of a weakly or sensitive constitution, and three for most Men. The easiest method of administration is to place the Globules on the tongue and allow them to dissolve. In acute or severe cases, twelve Globules may be mixed in six teaspoonfuls of pure cold water, and one teaspoonful administered every one or two hours; for Infants or young Children half a teaspoonful will suffice.

In chronic, or not urgent cases, the Globules should be taken dry, one dose each day for seven or eight days, then wait a week before repeating the same or selecting another remedy, unless fresh symptoms should arise, when the remedy indicated thereby should be immediately given.

During the use of Homœopathic remedies in any complaint, great care should be used in avoiding, as far as possible, fat, spiced, or other indigestible food, also all intoxicating or stimulating drinks.
