

HOMŒOPATHIC NEWS

The Sixth Convocation of the Vidarbha Board of Homœopathic and Biochemic Systems of Medicine, was held in Nagpur on Sunday, the 18th December 1960, at the Hindi Mor Bhavan when the D.H.B. Diploma was conferred on 174 students.

Dr. D. N. Chatterjee, Principal, D. N. De Homœopathic College, and Hospital, Calcutta, addressed the Convocation. Dr. W. S. Barlinge, Ph.D., Bar-at-Law, Ex-Minister for Public Health, Government of Madhya Pradesh, presided.

Dr. Barlinge in his presidential speech stressed the importance of non-surgical courses conducted by the Board to solve the Medical problems in India. He further said that Homœopathy can progress much if Government start Homœopathic dispensaries and Hospitals and give a separate directorate for Homœopathy.

Addressing the convocation Dr. Chatterjee, called on the Homœopaths to identify their interests with the common people and set a model of behaviour of the doctors towards their patients.

Earlier, Dr. N. Z. Nandurkar, Chairman of the Board introduced the guests and gave short history of the Board. The programme was started by welcome song sung by lady students of the local Homœopathic College and ended with Vande Mataram.

Two students Shri P. L. Kolhe, Mrs. Ushadevi Anant Joshi were awarded silver medal on the occasion.
