## TWO CLINICAL CASES OF TYPHOID FEVER

I was called for a Typhoid patient who had been suffering for fifteen days, with pains in all the joints, nausea, vertigo, eruptions all over the body, mental restlessness, and constipation, the stool being hard and as if burnt.

He was a Homoeopathic physician, and himself used: (1) Sulphur 1M for he got eruptions all over the body, had a psoric taint, pains in the joints, nausea and vertigo—; (2) Lachesis 200 for itching all over the body and for constipation; (3) Rhus Tox 200 for Typhoid fever, pains in the joints, nausea, eruptions and itching and for restlessness.

He was so weak that he could not move. He himself found the above symptoms and suggested to me to apply Arsenic Alb. in 200th potency, for restlessness and weakness.
