## TWO CLINICAL CASES OF RENAL COLIC

I was called in the evening of 4-6-55 to see a patient (who had been suffering from right-sided Renal Colic since last 5 days). Morphine by old school doctors were of no use to him.

The patient had a temperature of 104°, with throbbing pain in head and shooting and throbbing pains in the region of the kidney. His eyes were blood-shot. He was trying to leave his bed and was very restless.

I prescribed Belladonna 30, 8 doses, and advised his parents to give the medicine every ½ an hour. After the third dose, the severity of the pain became less. The patient slept. He got up after 4 hours and the pain was much less. He passed urine; the urine was kept in a glass. ¼ of an ounce of sand-like substance was seen at the bottom of the glass. Medicine was continued\*, the patient is quite alright and has no pains since that.

Mr. S., Sub-Inspector of Police, suddenly attacked with right-sided renal colic. Injections by allopathic doctors, instead of doing him some good, made the case worse.

He was bending over himself and on the painful side. He had passed no stool since the last 3 days. He was passing scanty urine, red—like blood. He was feeling much distress in the abdomen and was a bit relieved by passing urine. His stomach was distended. He only felt relief for a moment when little wind was passed.

I gave him Nux Vomica 30, one dose. After 2 hours I gave him Lycopodium 30, 4 powders to be taken every 2 hours. After the 2nd dose he passed stool and urine. He collected the urine in a glass-pot. Two very small pieces of white stone had been passed. After that he had no trouble and is a firm believer in the power of small doses of Homeopathic medicine.
