HOMŒOPATHIC NEWS

The 2nd World Homocopathic Medical Congress was held at Mexico from 17th to 22nd October, 1960. Dr. Rasik R. Thakar, D.D.M. (Germany) in his logg Presidential Address made the following observation:—

"The various legislatures in India are now considering Medical Bills to provide for Homeopathy which has been made so very prominent and popularised by those genuine Homœopaths and hence the Government of India and the world Homeopathic brotherhood both would be ill-advised if they constantly keep out of their purview three lakhs of such gifted Homeopaths of India who themselves can form a bigger political party or bigger the organisation than the World Homœo-. pathic Medical Congress of America or the International Homœopathic League of Europe. However, I regret very much to state that once the authorities of the League had the occasion to consider the situation in reference to two of our brothers from India at the Berlin Session in 1937. I may, therefore, request and suggest the authorities of the International Homœopathic League to make necessary amendments as regards the status of Homoopaths from India, so as to be flexible in reference to India, where the position of Homocopathic Science and its practitioners is altogether different from that of any other country of the world, as said above and really it is a very urgent and most important problem in view of the precarious plight of the Homœopathic Science and its all practitioners in India, where Homeopathy has been victimised in the hands of Racketeers, working under the patronage of veteran Congress leaders of India, who know nothing of Homeopathy, specially in Delhi and in bilingual Bombay State."

In that session Dr. Thakar invited the 3rd Session of the World Homœopathic Medical Congress to be held in 1962 in India.
