NOTIFICATION

The following amendment which has been made with the approval of the State Government by the General Council and State Faculty of Homœopathic Medicine, West Bengal in the Rules and Regulations published under Notification No. 1374-C/Medl. dated the 14th December, 1943, as subsequently amended, in exercise of the power conferred by section 10(a) of the Statutes promulgated under Government Resolution No. 1568 Medl. dated the 24th June, 1941 and all other powers enabling the Council in this behalf under the said Statutes, is hereby published for general information :—

Amendment.

After item 2(iv) of Regulation 5 of the Regulations regarding appointment of the Executive Committee and registration of Homœopathic practitioners the following shall be added as a new sub-clause :

Provided further that every person holding the degree of G.H.M.S. and the diploma of B.M.S. awarded by the Board of Homœopathic Medicine, U.P. since its establishment shall also be entitled to be registered in the register of registered practitioners on payment of prescribed fees.

INTERNATIONAL HAHNEMANNIAN SOCIETY OF INDIA
Silver Jubilee Celebration

Two-day session of the Silver Jubilee Celebration of the International Hahnemannian Society of India was successfully held at Mohabodhi Society Hall Calcutta on the 30th and 31st January, 1959. The function began with an opening song sung by Kumari Meeli Mukherjee and Sri Ehaskar Mukherjee.

Dr. A. B. Dutt, President, West Bengal Branch of the All India Homœopathic Medical Association and Chairman of the Reception Committee welcomed the guests and President of the celebration.

Dr. G. B. Patel, D.F. (London) Asst. Surgeon, Govt. Homœopathic Sanatorium at Nawegaon, Madhya Pradesh presided. Dr. D. N. Chatterjee, M.D. C.H., President of the All India Homœopathic Medical Association then requested Sri Sudhansu Kumar Bose, Editor, Hindusthan Standard to inaugurate the function and Sri Bose opened the function with a thought provoking speech on the efficacy of the Homœopathic system of treatment and urged the Government for its state recognition. After this Prof. Sri Panchanan Bhattacharya, M.L.A., Editor, Loksevak, delivered an eloquent speech as the Guest-in-Chief of the function. The Hony. Secretary read out the report of the society and the session was adjourned for the next day (31.1.59).

The Scientific session was held on 31.1.59 under the Chairmanship of Dr. B. K. Sarkar, M.B., D.M.S., Executive Chairman of the General Council and State Faculty of Homœopathic Medicine, West Bengal. Scientific papers written by Dr. Corea, Dr. S. Seal, Dr. Y. Sankaram, Dr. S. M. Biswas were read and

discussed. Also K. J. Sri Bagala Majumdar, Secretary, Bangiya Ayurvedigyan Parishad and Dr. B. C. Ukil spoke on this occasion. After this Dr. G. B. Patel delivered his concluding speech and some resolutions were passed. A health Film show was arranged for the guests assembled on this occasion by the courtesy of the Public Relation Department, Corporation of Calcutta, which was very much appreciated. Several messages of Goodwill were also received and read on this occasion. Among those the following may be mentioned. Sri D. P. Karmakar, Health Minister of India, Dr. S. K. Padiar of Kerala, Dr. C.V.S. Corea of Colombo, Dr. S. P. Mishra of Mazaffarpur, Dr. D. C. Kern of Patna, Dr. P. B. Dutta of Saktipur, Murshidabad, Dr. Saggu, Secretary, Bihar State Homœopathic Science Congress, Dr. J. Chowdhury of Puri (Orissa), Dr. M. H. Udani, President, Saurashtra, Homœopathic Medical Association (Rajkot). After a vote of thanks by Dr. S. Chaudhury the celebration came to a close, with a closing song sung by Kumari Anjali Nandy, Mamata Das and others.

The following Resolution moved and passed unanimously at the Silver Jubilee Celebration of the International Hahnemannian Society of India held at Mohabodhi Society Hall, Calcutta, on Friday the 30th January, 1959 at 4 P.M. under the Presidentship of Dr. G. B. Patel of Bombay.

1. Resolved that the Central Govt. of India be requested to implement forthwith the recommendations of the Homœopathic Enquiry Committee and those of the Homœopathic Ad-Hoc and Advisory Committee, with reference to the formation of the Central Homœopathic Council and State Homœopathic Boards; and to pass legislative enactment on Homœopathy on an All India basis, to ensure the status of the Homœopathic Practitioners in India and abroad.

2. Resolved that this meeting registers its emphatic protest against the recommendation of the Indian Medical Council to introduce Homœopathy only at a post-graduate level, as this step will lead to the eventual strangulation of the Homœopathic practice in the country.

3. (a) Resolved that the Govt. of West Bengal be requested

to bring about an early legislative enactment of the West Bengal Homœopathic Medical Bill, ensuring the standardisation of Homœopathic training and practice, the rights and privileges of Registered Homœopathic Practitioners and providing financial facilities for the development of Homœopathic Institutions, manufacturing concerns and Research works relating to Homœopathy.

(b) It is further resolved that the State Health Ministry, Govt. of West Bengal, be requested to grant registration for non-registered Homœopathic practitioners of West Bengal, under the General Council and State Faculty of Homœopathic Medicine, West Bengal.

BOOK REVIEW

Some Recent Research and Advances in Homœopathy—
By Dr. P. Sankaran, L.I.M., D.F. Hom. (Lond.) pages 23, priced at Rs. 2.00. Published by The Homœopathic Medical Publishers, 13-A, Station Road, Santa Cruz (West), Bombay-23.

This is a valuable booklet dealing, as the caption suggests, with almost all the scientific researches with the homœopathic potencies and in matters that support and prove the truth in the homœopathic Similia, attenuation and potentization. Dr. Starr's early findings, Dr. Abraham's great discoveries, Dr. Stearne's valuable experiments with Natrum Mur. upon guinea pigs, Dr. Boyd's electro-physical researches with the Emanometer, Dr. Patterson's Bowel Flora Researches and the Bowel Nosodes, recent provings of new drugs and reprovings of old ones, and Dr. Twentyman's Cancer treatments with Iscador, a preparation of Viscum Album, are the most outstanding of the many researches, widely and lucidly dealt with in the small treatise.
