Pathogenesis

Head Headache with nausea < 9-30 A.M. to 11.00 A.M.

Eyes Heaviness, upper eyelids > washing with cold water.

Burning sensation in upper eyelids > washing with cold water with mild heaviness.

Nose Coryza with discharge first thin & then turning to thick yellow < lying down, from cold bathing with uneasiness in back of head and neck in the evening.

Throat Irritation in throat > hot drink.

Stomach Thirst excessive.

Abdomen Pain cramping lower abdomen with ineffectual desire for stool and nausea.

Gripping pain around umbilicus with diarrhoea
< bending forward
< pressure
< movement
> cold application, after stool
