

A REVIEW OF INDIAN HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICINAL PLANTS WITH NOMENCLATURAL CHANGES AND SUBSTITUTIONS

ABSTRACT

Homoeopathic medicinal plants that have undergone nomenclatural changes as well as those medicinal plants that have altered drug names are reviewed for the benefit of research workers. A total of 98 species in 81 genera and 46 families of Homoeopathic medicinal plants in India are listed.

INTRODUCTION

Nomenclatural changes of medicinal plants useful in the system of Homoeopathy have a direct bearing on the drug names (Anon. 1971; Suresh Baburaj *et al.* 1992). As of date of submission of this paper, Dawre, Suresh Baburaj *et al.* 1987; Suresh Baburaj *et al.* 1992 and one more (in press) have listed the nomenclatural changes undergone in Indian Homoeopathic medicinal plants.

The present review appends the drug names which in many instances agree with the basionyms. As traders and physicians rely more on the drug name they are listed first in capitals followed by the valid botanical name in bold followed by the basionyms (listed in pharmacopoeae as 'synonyms') in italics. As the application of the rules of *International Code of Botanical Nomenclature* as well as the opinions and results of research work of systematic botanical monographers and revisionists using state of the art techniques will yield newer conscriptions, protogues and altered concepts of existing taxa, updating nomenclature changes and fixing correct botanical identity will be an ongoing process.
