Research in Homoeopathy and Influenza

Influenza is an important area within which to pursue well-targeted research in homoeopathy. The treat of a global pandemic of H5N1 avian influenza brings this view into sharper focus.

ISCHI invites applications for research funding in any aspect of homoeopathic medicine as applied in the treatment or prevention of influenza, including avian influenza. All forms of research design are eligible, including randomized clinical trials, clinical outcome studies and laboratory experiments.

Research funding that may be awarded for any given project will be judged on scientific merit and on the relevance of the application to the strategic aims of ISCHI. Grant arrangements involving co-sponsorship are encouraged.
