

A CASE OF CANCER

DR. S. N. SINGH, SHASTRI, D.H.Sc., VARANASI

Name—Moti Lal Seth. Male. Hindu. Age. 55 years, Shivpur, Varanasi.

Family History.—Nothing particular.

Previous History.—No history of venereal diseases. Remained all along very healthy. Five years ago he suffered from severe Bronchitis, which was cured with Allopathic Medicines. In January 62, he felt irritation on the right side of his tongue with hardness and burning for about 1 inch. Got himself examined at Shree Shivprasad Gupta Hospital, Varanasi. It was diagnosed as Cancer and he was advised treatment at Patna. He hurried to Patna where ten teeth were extracted. No benefit with electro-therapy.

Hence left the treatment after four months. Consulted his regular doctor at Varanasi, who advised Homœopathic treatment.

Symptoms—

Gum swollen, spongy, bleeding, breath offensive. Pain at the hard spot on the tongue. Aggravation, by movement of the tongue, at night. Sometimes has spasmodic pain extending upto right ear and right half of head. Has no taste. Sticky saliva, which causes the patient to wash the mouth too often. Cannot eat or drink easily. Sometimes mouth very dry. Unable to open the mouth to eat and chew.

Treatment. 10-6-62. —Mercurius Sol. 1m. three successive doses to be taken every fifteen mts. and to report after a work.

16-6-62. Remained in aggravation till this day. Today he stated that condition is as it was before administration of medicine but no night aggravation. Sac. Lac. for 7 days.

- 22-6-62. In this week during day he felt free from pain for one or two hours. He was requested to report daily a few days. On 24th it was noticed that there was no further improvement. Hence repeated the medicine with Sac. Lac. for one week.
- 28-6-62. Now the pain was not extending to ear and head. The pain in the tongue also reduced to $\frac{3}{4}$ as per wording of the patient.
- 8-7-62. Feeling no change since last three days. Carcinocin, 200 1 dose and Sac. Lac. for one week.
- 15-7-68. No change. Merc. Sol. 1m. one dose with Sac. Lac. for seven days.
- 22-7-62. He reported that pain was increased during this week. Sac. Lac. for 7 days.
- 3-8-62. No pain, no bleeding from gums and breath is less offensive. Can take milk and water very well. Can chew and eat but with difficulty. Patient was very much annoyed of his sticky saliva. Kali Bichrom. 1m 1 dose with Sac. Lac. for seven days.
- 10-8-62. Hardness in tongue reduced to $\frac{1}{6}$, but no change in saliva which seems too profuse. Sac. Lac. for seven days.
- 17-8-62. Saliva reduced. Can eat more conveniently. Sac. Lac. for seven days.
- 23-8-62. Much better in all respect. Sac. Lac. for 7 days.
- 31-8-62. No change in this week. Carcinocin 200 one dose with plenty of Sac. Lac. with request to return after 15 days.
- 13-9-62. The patient reported that now he has no trouble except a very little hard spot in the tongue. Now feeling taste of the things he eats. No medicine. He has been advised to report after a month.
