

HOW BACILLINUM CURES RINGWORM

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A young Professor aged 25 had been suffering from Ringworm since 7 or 8 years. In the month of August 1958, when I was consulted I found that the disease had spread over the whole of the scrotum as well as over a large portion of both the thighs adjacent to it. The skin of the diseased area had turned dark and grown thick. The itching was very troublesome and annoying. The worse periods of the ailment were the rainy and winter seasons. The Professor had a rather robust constitution. He had a family history of tuberculosis. He was afraid of dogs.

I gave him a dose of Bacillinum 1M in pilules dry on the tongue. There was aggravation on the fifth day. The area where the disease was lodged began to ooze some sort of liquid matter which produced intense burning. The Professor who had gone to take his classes at 10 A.M. hurried back home after about an hour and told me that the pain was so intense and unbearable that he had to leave the classes unfinished. He lay restless in his study. First I thought that he should be asked to grin and bear the pain, but as there were definite symptoms of Arsenic Alb. I gave him a dose of Arsenic Alb. 30 and repeated the same after half an hour. Lo! the effect of Arsenic Alb. was indeed marvellous. The Professor fell into a sound sleep and woke up after two hours. He remarked that all pain was gone but the oozing was still continuing in some what lesser degree. The effect of the drugs was nothing short of a miracle next day when to the utter surprise of every one present including some doctors of the orthodox school the dark and crusty ringworm had vanished leaving behind white husk-like substance peeling off and dropping down. The cure was perfect and permanent.
