HOMŒOPATHY WINS THE LAUREL

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Indu, nicknamed Vakil Saheb, a two-and-a-half-year old boy of a rich family known as Narhan Raj in the District of Darbhanga suffered from stomach trouble in Nov. 1951. Some local eminent allopaths diagnosed it as Infantile liver. Some medicines were administered but with no effect. The case was declared hopeless at the long last. The parents of the boy thought of taking him to Lucknow to put him under Zamin's liver-cure. But the reported death of a child of a big businessman of Darbhanga under the said Zamin's liver cure made the parents hesitant. In the period of indecision I was requested to treat the boy. Presumably the father of the boy thought of taking a chance as an interim arrangement. Under these peculiar circumstances, I took up the case. The enlargment of the liver was found about 3 inch. long. There was obstinate constipation. On query, it transpired that the mother of the boy suffered from stomach troubles and abscess while the child was in the womb. Carduus ø was administered. It had some effect. The function of the liver improved.

At one stage, passing of urine altogether stopped. A few doses of Apocynum 30, were given. The case looked critical. An eminent allopath of Darbhanga declared the condition alarming. Slowly but gradually every trouble disappeared. After about 1 year the boy regained normal health. He is well-progressing for last 6 years.
