Arsenicum 36c. after an attack and was cured. The œdematous condition was cured by Helleborus 9c. (Muehlenbein.)

- 48. Woman of 40 has had three severe attacks of tertian malaria. During the apyrexia Ipecacuanha was given minus result. *Arsenicum* 30c. cured. (Schreter.)
- 49. Man of 25, formerly healthy, developed quartan malaria which was suppressed by quinine, after which hydrops set in with daily attacks of malaria at uncertain hours. Symptoms: General anasarca especially of thighs, scrotum and abdomen. Daily fever attacks at irregular hours, mild chills, much stretching and backache; severe heat with thirst and headache. Oppression to chest with anxiety and restlessness; pressing pains over stomach and liver; face yellow, sallow, puffed; bitter taste, tongue coated, stool normal; urine scanty, dark-red. Insomnia, night sweats.

Arsenicum 30c. reduced in a week much of the swelling, increased the quantity of urine, and relieved the extreme anxiety and restlessness. Natrum muriaticum finishd the treatment. (Schulz.)

## NOTIFICATION

The Governor is pleased to make the following amendments in the Statutes of the General Council & State Faculty of Homœopathic Medicine published under Government of Bengal Resolution No. 1568-Medl. dated 24th June, 1941 at pages 1594 to 1599 of Part I of the Calcutta Gazette of the 3rd July, 1941, as subsequently amended in so far as the said statutes relate to West Bengal.

## AMENDMENTS.

In the said statutes-

- (a) In articles 1, 2, 10(c) and 28 for the word "Bengal" wherever it occurs substitute the words "West Bengal".
- (b) In clause (b) of article 2 and in article 28, for the word "five" wherever it occurs substitute the word "two".
- (c) Delete clause (e) and (g) of article 2.
- (d) In clause (k) of article 2 add the words "West Bengal Legislative" before the word "Assembly" and delete the words "and one member of the Council".
