A CLINICAL CASE

A woman aged about 30 was suffering from pain in the abdomen in the Right ileo-cœcal region extending to the naval. The pain was intermittent and severe. He had nausea and vomiting. Could not take anything but liquid food in small quantity. After suffering for some months, she consulted a retired D.M.O. who is a good surgeon. She was operated upon by the D.M.O. in the local government Hospital and after a month discharged. She had no pain and was well.

After a month the pain returned which was more severe and continuous. The nausea and vomiting accompanied. She had besides intense thirst for cold water which was vomited after few minutes. No food at all for seven days. Badly constipated and urine scanty. Severe stitching pain in the operated region. She again consulted the Surgeon. She was admitted in the Hospital and kept under observation for nine days during which period she was treated with injections, medicines and enemas. No response. A second operation was advised. The patient was too weak so she refused. Discharged on 14-3-52.

She placed herself under my treatment on 16-3-52. Her intense thirst for cold water which was vomited after few minutes, incessant nausea, constipation and post operative pain and vomit guided me to select Phosphorus which was given in 30 potency, 4 doses, every three hours. The effect was wonderful. The first dose relieved her nausea, the second her thirst. After the third dose, she had profuse vomiting of dark clotted blood with bad smelling fæcal matter with glairy mucus. She felt hungry and a few spoonful of Barley water was retained. After the fourth dose her bowel moved after nine days in spite of enemas given in the Hospital. She felt better alround. She was under Sac Lac for ten days while getting nourishing food. She is now completely cured.
