PROPOSALS UNDER INDIAN MEDICAL AND HOMOEOPATHY SYSTEM

1127. SHRI GODSE HEMANT TUKARAM:

Will the Minister of **AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH)** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has received any proposals under the Indian Medical Homoeopathy system from the Government of Maharashtra during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of proposals that have been disposed of so far;
- (d) the number of proposals under the consideration of Union Government at present; and
- (e) the time by which these pending proposals are likely to be cleared?

(a) & (b): The Ministry of AYUSH has received 9 proposals to increase admission capacity of existing Under-graduate and Post-graduate courses of Ayurveda and to start new Post-graduate courses of Ayurveda from Government of Maharashtra during the last three years. The detail is given at Annexure- I.

The status of proposals received under erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Scheme for development of AYUSH hospitals and dispensaries during 2013-14 and under National AYUSH Mission during 2014-15 & 2015-16 from the State of Maharashtra is enclosed at Annexure II.

(c): The proposals received and disposed of under erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Scheme for development of AYUSH hospitals and dispensaries during 2013-14 and under National AYUSH Mission during 2014-15 & 2015-16 from the State of Maharashtra is enclosed at Annexure II.

All the 9 proposals to increase admission capacity of existing Under-graduate and Post-graduate courses of Ayurveda and to start new Post-graduate courses of Ayurveda from Government of Maharashtra during the last three years have been disposed of in time.

(d) & (e): All the eligible proposals as per the guidelines of the Scheme and as per the provision under General Financial Rules (GFR) including Ministry of Finance guidelines on pending Utilization Certificates have been approved.
