

Ordinance to revamp homoeopathy body gets nod

New Delhi:

In its effort to bring in transparency and accountability in alternative medicines, the Union Cabinet today approved an ordinance which will replace the existing Central Council of Homoeopathy with a National Commission of Homoeopathy to regulate and standardise homoeopathy education and treatment in the country.

The commission, similar to the National Medical Commission, will comprise of seven persons who will be eminent homoeopaths and administrators, and will be appointed by the government. Once appointed, these members will replace the existing functionaries of the council.
