Chapter Mouth

Origin of the Project :

Of all the repertories Kent's is the most complete and therefore the best. It is also popular. The first edition of this repertory was published in 1897 in America containing 1349 pages. It is a product of long evolution from Boeninghausen's and other repertories. The last edition was published in 1916 and it contains references to 648 Homoeopathic drugs. Lot of drugs have since been extensively proved and which need to be incorporated properly. For instance William Boericke's repertory contains references to 1414 Homoeopathic drugs. Keeping this in view a project to review Kent's repertory was initiated in the Regional Research Institute for Homoeopathy New Delhi in the year 1972.

Purpose :

The purpose of the project was to incorporate

additions from William Boericke's repertory as edited by Dr. Oscar E. Boericke to Kent's repertory, thereby, improving and enlarging the scope of Kent's monumental work and making it available to the profession at large for its utilisation for the noble cause of serving the suffering humanity.

Special Features :

1. Quotations have been cited in original from books referred wherever confirmed.
2. For the purpose of recommending additions a thorough comparative study of the two repertories chapterwise / rubricwise was undertaken as a "priori".
3. New Rubrics/sub rubrics have been recommended for inclusion in the Kent's repertory wherever found necessary on the basis of the study.

Note : The research project is in relation with Kent's Repertory, and W. Boericke's *meteria medica* with repertory, Clark's Dictionary and Allen's Encyclopaedias.

Method of Procedure :

(1) Additions have been mainly recommended on the basis of following points :—

(i) After confirmation from the known source books referred wherever possible.

(ii) Where the sources could not be verified and have been done so on Boericke's own authority.

2. In order to maintain the uniformity of standards and avoid fallacies Drugs mentioned in italics and ordinary letters in Boericke's repertory have been recommended for inclusion under lowest

grade only in the Kent's repertory for the time being.

3. For the purposes of deciding about synonymy of rubrics in both the repertories Blackinstons Medical Dictionary (New Gould) has been consulted.

4. Generalised rubrics in Boericke's repertory have been split up according to Kentian method and additional drugs thereafter recommended for inclusion accordingly.

5. Rubrics having vague expressions and too much generalised in Boericke's repertory have been left beyond the scope of present study

6. Additional rubrics found in Boericke's repertory have also been recommended for inclusion if they are found in accordance with the philosophy of Kent's repertory.

7. The recommendations made by the concerned Research Workers were finally subjected to thorough scrutiny by a Working Group of the Scientific Advisory committee consisting of experts in the field of repertory before presenting it to the profession. Doubts were also resolved at the stage.
