BERBERIS VULGARIS

(Barberry)

Introduction

Berberis vulgaris Linn. commonly known as Barberry was proved by Dr. Hesse, and published in the Journal for Materia Medica in 1834. This drug affects particularly the lumbar region, kidneys and uterus. Rheumatic affections are also prominent. It is a great anti-lithiatic medicine.

Description

A deciduous shrub having roots of pale yellow colour. The plant is 1-2.5 meter high and even higher under under cultivation, with throny alternate, angular branches. Leaves in tufts, somewhat obovate, more or less pointed, serrated and fringed, and with three cleft spreading, sharp thorns at the base of each leaf bud. Flowers in drooping, many-flowered racemes, golden yellow with red glands. Fruit a berry, oblong in loose bunches.

Discussion

During CCRH's clinical verification, the efficacy of Berberis vulgaris for renal and gall stone complaints have been reconfirmed. In biliary colic 29 patients improved symptomatically out of 47 and in renal colic 755 patients were relieved symptomatically out of 798. Its chief modality aggravation from movement has been clinically verified too.

Although it is predominantly indicated for left sided renal complaints yet in our study it has relieved right sided renal complaints too. The same observation has been quoted by Dr. Clarke in his book "A Dictionary of Practical Materia Medica Vol.1" This drug has also relieved several cases of flat warts.
