GYNÆCOLOGICAL DRUGS

1. LATE ONSET OF MENSES

Natrum mur. Late developers mentally as well as physically; "young for

their age", immature outlook. Greasy skin, reserved, fond

of salt. Tend to be rather over weight.

Weepy, changeable type, Sometimes placid, sometimes irri-Pulsatilla

table. Irritability is more noticeable in teenagers than in young children. More than usually difficult adolescents.

2. DYSMENORRHŒA

Severe pain, usually heavy flow, membranous type. Pain Tub. bov.

precedes flow, mainly L. sided. Usually severe premenstrual mental tension-extra tired and irritable, and often have a couple of sleepless nights immediately preceding the

flow.

Mag. phos. Predominant symptom—lower abdominal colic. Pain pre-

cedes flow. Mainly R. sided. > heat and pressure.

Accompanied by abdominal flatulence.

In "Phos. type": Dark, tall, slender, nervous, highly strung,

worried about themselves.

Pain mainly in back. Calc. phos.

Flow heavy and bright.

Useful especially in younger patients.

Calc. phos. type: Fair, thin, easily tired, tend to get study

headaches.

Tend to turn ankles, or have some sort of foot trouble.

Tend to have long thin feet (a useful confirmatory point).

Cocculus

Crippling dysmenorrhæa in which the constitutional dis-

turbance predominates:

Giddiness, faintness, and vomiting.

Occipital headache.

Accompanied by chilliness and numbness of limbs.

Flow profuse, dark.

May result from overwork.

Viburnum opulus

Membranous dysmenorrhea with severe cramp before

flow-sometimes for several days before.

Rather violent throbbing headache movement,

< stooping.

Lies quite still.

Flow often scanty for first 2 or 3 days, then increases. As it increases, cramps disappear, but backache comes on.

> pressure, lying down.

Cimicifuga Lachesis As last, but pains spread down into thighs.

Especially older patients.

L. sided. Pain relieved once flow starts.

Wakes with pain.

Very dark, almost black flow.

Usually some jealousy present somewhere.

Note: (a) Psychological factors leading to tension.

(b) Lack of exercise.

3. MENORRHAGIA

Constitutional symptoms are paramount for prescribing purposes.

Calc. carb.

All ages.

Flow very heavy, not much clotted.

< exertion.

Type: Heavily built, pale, flabby, sweats, chilly feet.

"Worrying mind with a lethargic body".

Belladonna

Bright red flow and bright red patient.

Clots usually present.

Throbbing in pelvis and head. Often high blood pressure.

Abdomen sensitive. (Low potencies best).

Ferrum met.

Heavy periods. Some nausea. Throbbing headache.

Type: Anæmic, overweight.

Have a very bright colour (of Bell.).

Intolerant of iron.

Sensitive to changes of atmosphere. Dislike stuffy atmo-

sphere, but also dislike cold.

Phosphorus

Period prolonged, though not so heavy as in above reme-

dies.

Hates blood, frightened of it and about it, worried about

themselves, generally upset.

Type: Tall, thin, dark or reddish hair. Sometimes freckled. Chilly, aggravated ++ by wind, hate it and upset by it

mentally and physically.

Pulsatilla

Late onset of menses may be followed by irregularity in

timing, quantity and pain.

Sabina

Bright red flow, clots.

Tends to be hot and throw off clothes. Useful where constitutional remedies fail.

First choice in threatened abortion (use 10M).

Sulphyr

Heavy usually.

Troublesome irritation with period, especially towards end.

< heat, light, washing. Often burning.

Millefolium Ipecac.

Hæmorrhage in general. Bright red, difficult to stop.

Ipecac. always has nausea, which distinguishes.

4. FIBROIDS

Respond best when they tend to regress anyway.

Calc. carb.

Prescribe on constitutional symptoms.

Calc. phos. Calc. fluor.

Very hard fibroids.

Phosphorus

Polypoid type, maybe with a cervical polyp.

Tend to produce intermittent intermenstrual bleeding.

(Beware of carcinoma in these cases.) Prescribe on constitutional symptoms.

Sulphur

Softens fibroids.

Fraxinus

Bearing down sensations. Patient should be Sepia but isn't.

5. MENOPAUSE

Lachesis

Jealousy, possessiveness, some mental disturbance of this

type.

Sepia

Weary indifference. Can't be bothered. Everything is a

nuisance.

With both:

Almost always severe headaches just before a period

appears.

6. STERILITY

Tub. bov.

On general constitutional indications.

Natrum mur.

Previous use of chemical contraceptives can be a cause,

Sepia

especially the quinine type-Nat. mur.

Indifference, especially to intercourse—Sepia.

7. PRURITIS

Menopausal or post-menopausal.

Usually complementary to mental anxiety and strain.

Very difficult to treat.

N.B. exclude: Monilia, Trichomonas, leucorrhœa, diabetes.

Ars. alb.

May be > warm bathing.

Burning.

Worries.

Pulsatilla

> cold bathing.

Sulphur

< any bathing. Burning.

Radium brom.

Extreme soreness and tenderness of skin.
