

LATRODECTUS MACTANSE

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Mr. P. G. B. sent me an urgent call. He was having pain in the precordial region shooting down both the arms, cold clammy perspiration on the head, hands and feet cold, restless. B.P. 110/60, pulse 100 soft.

I immediately diagnosed it as Coronary thrombosis. *Latrodectus mac.* 200 was given and waited for Half hour. Patient was slightly better. I repeated again one dose and waited for one hour. Patient was much better. Precordial pain was much less. Restlessness, coldness of the extremities improved and the patient slept for couple of hours.

He now began to complain of discomfort in the epigastric region and would not take any food because of the discomfort. Even water he would take in sips only, tongue was coated and dry. After trying a few remedies I hit upon *Ars. Iod.* 30. After a few doses of *Ars. Iod.* 30 patient felt much better; in fact he and other doctor friends began to doubt my diagnosis of Coronary thrombosis. But I had examined the blood which showed Leucocytosis and the B.S.R. was increased. Both in favour of Coronary Thrombosis.

After a fortnight the Patient insisted that the diagnosis should be confirmed by Electrocardiogram. So electrocardiogram was taken and it confirmed my diagnosis.
